## Regularly Assigned Homework

- 15 Minutes of Home Reading (Minimum 5 Days per Week)
- Math Connections: Students will be assigned a weekly math task, due Wednesdays
- Current Events: Students are required to report to the class on a news article or story once per month (Note: There is no set due date, as I would like students to bring in or discuss articles or stories that interest them.)
